In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT INCREASING THE DISTRIBUTIVE SHARE OF THE ESTATE OF A DECEASED PERSON TO WHICH THE SURVIVING SPOUSE IS ENTITLED WHERE THERE IS KINDRED AND ISSUE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. paragraph (1) of section 1 of chapter 190 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 316 of the
3 acts of 1956, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 3 and
4 4, 6, 8 and 9, and 25, the words "twenty-five thousand" and
5 inserting, in each instance, the words: — fifty thousand

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply only in cases of estates of
2 persons dying on or after January first, nineteen hundred and
3 seventy-one.
