AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE GOVERNOR TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION AND THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RELATIVE TO HIGHWAY TRANSPORTATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The governor, on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby
2 authorized to enter into a cooperative agreement with the
3 Interstate Commerce Commission and the United States
4 Department of Transportation pursuant to section 205(f) of
5 the Interstate Commerce Act (49U.S.C. 305(f) to enforce the
6 economic and safety laws and regulations of the various
7 states and the United States concerning highway transpor-
8 tation; provided, however, that any such agreement shall be
9 revocable upon thirty days' notice by the governor or by a
10 joint resolution of the two branches of the general court.
