Accompanying the eleventh recommendation of the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (House, No. 17). Government Regulations.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE PROCEDURE FOR ENACTING REGULATIONS BY THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONTROL COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 24 and inserting in place thereof the
3 following: —

4 The commission shall, in accordance with chapter thirty A
5 and with the approval of the governor, makes regulations not
6 inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter for clarifying,
7 carrying out, enforcing and preventing violation of, all and any
8 of its provisions, for inspection of the premises and method of
9 carrying on the business of any licensee, for insuring the
10 purity, and penalizing the adulteration, or in any way changing
11 the quality or content, of any alcoholic beverage, for the
12 proper and orderly conduct of the licensed business, for estab-
13 lishing maximum prices chargeable by licensees under this chap-
14 ter, and regulating all advertising of alcoholic beverages, except
15 such advertising as appears in publications which are circulated
16 to the liquor trade and not to the general public, and shall,
17 with like approval, make regulations governing the labelling of
18 packages of alcoholic beverages as to their ingredients and the
19 respective quantities thereof.
