The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC AS TO THE QUALITY OF PETROLEUM PRODUCT PURCHASED FOR MOTOR FUEL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 All gasoline or other motor fuel offered for sale, sold or
2 delivered to a purchaser in this Commonwealth shall be
3 branded and each and every product shall have a brand name.
4 Each and every brand shall be registered together with identi-
5 fying quality specifications with the director of the Division of
6 Standards, such specifications shall include octane number if
7 gasoline. Whoever fails or neglects to comply with these re-
8 quirements shall be punished for the first offense by a fine of
9 not less than fifty dollars, for the second offense by a fine of
10 not less than two-hundred dollars and for each subsequent
11 offense by a fine of not less than five-hundred dollars.
