AN ACT GRANTING TO THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION IN MEDICINE
THE USE OF EXPERT ADVICE AND ASSISTANCE IN DEVISING AND
CONDUCTING EXAMINATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out section 3 and inserting in place thereof the fol-
- 3 lowing section: —
- 4 *Section 3.* Examinations shall be in whole or in part in
- 5 writing in English and shall be sufficiently thorough to ade-
- 6 quately test the applicant's fitness to practice medicine. The
- 7 board may employ expert advice and assistance in the conduct
- 8 of its examinations.
