AN ACT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF STATE EXAMINERS OF PLUMBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 37, as most recently amended by
3 chapter 102 of the acts of 1966, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following section: —

5 *Section 37.* The examiners shall hold two regular meetings
