AN ACT DESIGNATING INTERSTATE I-290, WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH, AS THE STATE POLICE MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Except as provided in chapter 625 of the acts of 1962, that
2 portion of interstate highway Route I-290, within the common-
3 wealth, shall be designated and known as the state police
4 memorial highway, and suitable markers bearing said designa-
5 tion shall be erected thereon by the department of public
6 works; provided, however, that said markers do not conflict
7 with the federal regulations for the national system of inter-
8 state and defense highways.
