Accompanying the twenty-seventh recommendation of the Department of Public Works (House, No. 259). Transportation.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN OTHER PUBLIC LANDS FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subject to the provisions of chapter 693 of the acts of 1955,  
2 as amended, the Department of Public Works of the common-  
3 wealth, acting for and on behalf of the commonwealth, is  
4 hereby authorized to acquire by eminent domain under chapter  
5 79 of the General Laws, or to acquire by purchase or other-  
6 wise, the public lands hereinafter described, or such portions  
7 thereof as said department may determine, and to divert said  
8 lands from their present public uses to highway use, as herein-  
9 after provided.

10 Said lands to be so transferred and diverted are shown on a  
11 map entitled "Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of  
12 Public Works - Public Lands Needed for Highway Purposes,  
13 November 4, 1970", which said department is hereby directed  
14 to file in the office of the secretary of the commonwealth and  
15 which said secretary is hereby authorized to receive for filing  
16 and are identified as follows: -

17 1. Approximately five and four tenths acres in an eighty  
18 foot width of taking beginning at and near the northerly  
19 boundary of the Reservation land under control by the  
20 Trustees of Reservations in the Town of Chesterfield, then  
21 going southerly for a distance of approximately two thousand

22 feet and curving easterly and ending at the easterly boundary  
 23 of this reservation. Northeastern boundary of land at Main  
 24 Road five hundred feet east of intersection of Main Road and  
 25 Smith Road.
