AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN LANDS OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subject to the provisions of chapter 693 of the acts of 1955,
2 as amended, the boards, officers and agencies having control of
3 the lands of the commonwealth hereinafter described are
4 hereby authorized and directed to transfer said lands, or such
5 portions thereof as the department of public works of the
6 commonwealth may determine, to the control of said depart-
7 ment, and said department is hereby authorized to divert said
8 lands from their present public uses to highway use, as herein-
9 after provided.

10 Said lands to be so transferred and diverted are shown on a
11 map entitled "Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of
12 Public Works - Public Lands Needed for Highway Purposes,
13 November 4, 1970", which said department is hereby directed
14 to file in the office of the secretary of the commonwealth and
15 which said secretary is hereby authorized to receive for filing,
16 and are identified as follows: -

17 1. In the town of Monterey, approximately eight acres along
18 the southerly boundary of the Swann State Forest and a
19 portion of the Beartown State Forest, as shown on said map,
20 now under the control of the Department of Natural Resources
21 and dedicated to forestry and recreation purposes, to be used
22 for the relocation of Route 23.
