RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MAURICE TOBIN MEMORIAL BRIDGE AS A TOLL FREE ROAD.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-  
3 tives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is  
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
5 and study of the legislative history of the Maurice Tobin  
6 Memorial Bridge, formerly called the Mystic River Bridge,  
7 spanning the Mystic river between the city of Chelsea and  
8 the Charlestown district of the city of Boston, including the  
9 provisions of chapter five hundred and sixty-two of the acts of  
10 nineteen hundred and forty-six and chapter four hundred and  
11 sixty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-six, with  
12 particular reference to the net amount of revenue received  
13 by the former Mystic River Bridge Authority during its owner-  
14 ship of said bridge and amount of money paid to the bondhold-  
15 ers, and to determine the revenue received by the Massachusetts  
16 Port Authority attributable to the operation of such bridge to  
17 assist in determining when such bridge can be operated by the  
18 commonwealth as a toll free road.

19 Said commission may require by summons the attendance  
20 and testimony of witnesses and the production of books and  
21 papers.
