By Mr. Ryan of Haverhill, petition of William H. Ryan that the Department of Public Safety be directed to acquire certain land in the city of Haverhill adjacent to Interstate Highway Route I-495 for the purpose of constructing thereon a state police substation and a tourist information and first aid center. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A STATE POLICE SUBSTATION AND A TOURIST INFORMATION AND FIRST AID CENTER ON INTERSTATE HIGHWAY ROUTE I-495 IN THE CITY OF HAVERHILL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public safety is hereby authorized to, and
2 shall, acquire by purchase, gift, or eminent domain land in the
3 city of Haverhill adjacent to interstate highway route I-495 for
4 the purpose of constructing thereon a building properly
5 equipped and furnished for use as a substation for the state
6 police and or a tourist information and first aid center. Said
7 department may expend such sums as may be appropriated
8 therefor.
