## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY SHALL ESTABLISH CENTERS FOR PHOTOGRAPHING ELDERLY APPLICANTS FOR IDENTIFICATION CARDS IN CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Subsection (*e 1/2*) of section 5 of chapter 161A of the  
2 General Laws, inserted by section 1 of chapter 574 of the acts  
3 of 1969, is hereby amended by adding the following sen-  
4 tence: — In every city or town within the territory of said  
5 Authority which has a population of over fifty thousand per-  
6 sons, the Authority shall establish and maintain facilities for  
7 photographing applicants for such identification cards.
