AN ACT REQUIRING PERSONS RIDING ON A SNOWMOBILE TO WEAR PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 26 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 26A.* No person shall operate or ride on a snow-
- 4 mobile unless he wears protective headgear conforming with
- 5 such minimum standards of construction and performance as
- 6 the director may prescribe. Whoever violates any provision of
- 7 this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than fifty
- 8 dollars.
