AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FOR TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT IN A HIGHER CLASSIFICATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE COM-MONWEALTH

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 24B of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as most
- 2 recently amended, is hereby further amended by striking out
- 3 the second paragraph in its entirety and inserting in place
- 4 thereof the following: -
- 5 This section shall not apply to assignment of a person to
- 6 cover a higher position when the holder of the higher grade
- 7 position is absent on vacation leave, but shall apply when the
- 8 holder of such higher graded position is absent for any other
- 9 reason.
