**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FOR TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT
IN A HIGHER CLASSIFICATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE COM-
MONWEALTH.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 24B of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended, is hereby further amended by striking out
3 the second paragraph in its entirety and inserting in place
4 thereof the following: —

5 This section shall not apply to assignment of a person to
6 cover a higher position when the holder of the higher grade
7 position is absent on vacation leave, but shall apply when the
8 holder of such higher graded position is absent for any other
9 reason.
