AN ACT AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN PENSION OR RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR PERSONS RECEIVING LESS THAN AN ANNUAL PENSION OF THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law,
- 2 all former employees of the commonwealth, counties, cities,
- 3 towns and districts who are now receiving a pension or retire-
- 4 ment allowance under any of the provisions of chapter 32 of
- 5 the General Laws, of less than three thousand dollars annually
- 6 shall have such pension or retirement allowance increased to
- 7 three thousand dollars.
