### AN ACT INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 17 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the third sentence, as most recently  
3 amended by section 20 of chapter 766 of the acts of 1969,  
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — The  
5 commissioner shall receive a salary of thirty-seven thousand  
6 dollars and shall devote his full time during business hours to  
7 the duties of his office.
