The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION, TO PAY THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN LAY TEACHERS IN PRIVATE AND PAROCHIAL SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the common-
2 wealth, subject to the approval of the board of education, is
3 hereby authorized to pay the salary of each lay teacher in
4 parochial and private schools in the cities and towns of the
5 commonwealth in the grades of kindergarten to twelfth grade,
6 inclusive; provided, that their teaching class does not include
7 any religious or denominational instruction.
