AN ACT PROVIDING OPEN AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING BY THE  
GROUP INSURANCE COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Section 4 of chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding after the word "benefits" and before the  
3 word "covering" the following: — on a full semi-private master  
4 medical program or its equivalent by open competitive bidding.
