**AN ACT PROVIDING THAT MEMBERS OF THE POLICE FORCE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS BE CLASSIFIED IN GROUP 4 UNDER THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.**
