AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN AFFIDAVITS FROM CERTAIN WELFARE APPLICANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2B of chapter 118 of the General
2 Laws, as inserted by section 19 of chapter 885 of the acts of
3 1970, is hereby amended by inserting in the first sentence after
4 the words, "under sixteen years of age;" the words: — the
5 name and residence of the father of each dependent child.

1 SECTION 2. If this act shall be in violation of any federal
2 rule or regulation established by the department of health,
3 education, and welfare which must be met as a condition for
4 receiving federal funds in connection with any program admin-
5 istered by the department of public welfare, it shall be null and
6 void.
