AN ACT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF ASSOCIATE JUDGES OF THE
LAND COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 185 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 2 and inserting in place thereof the follow-
3 ing section: —

4 *Section 2.* There shall be four judges of the court, one of
5 whom shall be appointed, commissioned and qualified as judge
6 and the other three as associate judges.
