AN ACT TO AMEND THE MASSACHUSETTS ANTI-LAPSE STATUTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 That the term "Other Relation" within the Anti-Lapse
- 2 Statute shall be interpreted as meaning other blood relation or
- 3 other adopted relation.
