AN ACT AUTHORIZING VIETNAM VETERANS TO ATTEND SUMMER SESSIONS AND EVENING CLASSES CONDUCTED BY COMMUNITY COLLEGES WITHOUT CHARGE FOR TUITION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 39 of chapter 15 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following sentence: — Vietnam veterans  
3 may attend such summer sessions and evening classes tuition  
4 free. Community colleges shall be reimbursed by the common-  
5 wealth for the cost of instruction to each Vietnam veteran who  
6 attends such summer sessions and such evening classes.
