AN ACT MAKING PERMANENT CERTAIN TEMPORARY POSITIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 6 of chapter 507
2 of the acts of 1960, the general appropriation act for the fiscal
3 year 1970 or of any provision of any supplementary appropria-
4 tion act for said fiscal year, the number of permanent positions
5 duly approved, with reference to each item thereby approp-
6 riated for personal services, shall be increased to include, in
7 each case, every year-round temporary position (1) for which,
8 for a continuous period of three years prior to January first,
9 nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, compensation has been duly
10 paid or authorized under the same or a like item in prior
11 appropriation acts, and (2) which exists in connection with the
12 maintenance of the state department of public works or the
13 performance of any service by said department required or
14 provided for by virtue of any general act the operation of
15 which is not expressly limited as to time. The director of
16 personnel shall, by title and code number and subject to
17 approval of the commission on administration and finance,
18 certify to the budget commissioner, the comptroller, the direc-
19 tor of civil service, the appointing authority concerned, and the
20 house and senate committees on ways and means, each such
21 position to be so included. The provisions of this act shall not
22 apply to any present temporary position created by any general
23 or special act the operation of which is expressly limited as to
24 time, nor to any such position which by its nature or intent is
25 temporary.
