AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE BE DEEMED CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subdivision (1) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph (n), added
- 3 by chapter 625 of the acts of 1969, the following paragraph: —
- 4 (o) Credit shall be allowed for accumulated sick leave
- 5 remaining unused at the time of retirement.
