AN ACT ESTABLISHING A FLAT EXEMPTION OF A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY DUE FOR TAXES BY THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OF CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause Forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 728 of the acts of
3 1966, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word
4 "domicile", in line 6, the words: – or the surviving spouse of a
5 person seventy years of age or over who meets all the require-
6 ments of this clause except for age.
