AN ACT PERMITTING CERTAIN MINORS TO WORK IN OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE THE SCHOOL HE ATTENDS IS NOT IN SESSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 62 of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end thereof, the following sen-
3 tence: — Nor shall this section prohibit the employment of a
4 minor who is a student in the operation of a motor vehicle
5 while the school which he attends is not in session and the
6 employment is not of a permanent and full-time nature.
