## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS TO ESTABLISH SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE PROFESSIONAL STAFF OF THE UNIVERSITY MEDICAL SCHOOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 35 of chapter 75 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out all of the first sentence thereof fol-  
3 lowing the words "salary for the dean" and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following: — provided, however, that the trustees  
5 may establish the salaries for the dean, officers and members of  
6 the professional staff having a classification rating equal to or  
7 higher than that of associate professor and for the members of  
8 the professional teaching staff without reference to the general  
9 salary schedule and salary range.
