AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DISPLAY OF NUMBER PLATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the last sentence thereof, the fol-
3 lowing sentence: —

4 Any motor vehicle or trailer may, if duly registered, be
5 operated, pushed, drawn or towed upon or remain upon any
6 way between the hours of twelve o'clock noon on the date on
7 which its registration expires, and twelve o'clock noon on the
8 following day, if the following day is the first day of the
9 vehicle's new registration period, if such vehicle or trailer dis-
10 plays its register number for either registration period as other-
11 wise required by this section.
