AN ACT INCREASING THE MEAL ALLOWANCE OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The director of personnel and standardization is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to promulgate rules and regulations pro-
3 viding that any state employee who in his official capacity is
4 required to travel shall be awarded a meal allowance of one
5 dollar and fifty cents for breakfast, two dollars for lunch and
6 four dollars for supper.
