The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE STATE SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION GRANT FOR ANY SCHOOL PROJECT BE EQUAL TO SIXTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE FINAL APPROVED COST OF THE PROJECT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1948, as amended, is
2 hereby further amended by striking out the first paragraph and
3 clauses (a), (b), (c) and (d) and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph: --

5 The total construction grant for any approved school project
6 for any city, town, county or regional school district shall be
7 sixty-five percent of the final approved cost of such project.
