By Mr. Bowes of Barnstable, petition of Charles A. Coyle for legislation to regulate the sales of alcoholic beverages during certain morning hours on Sundays or legal holidays. Government Regulations.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

### AN ACT REGULATING ANTEMERIDIAN SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAY OR LEGAL HOLIDAYS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 33 of chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out in the second paragraph the following  
3 words: — “no other licensee under section twelve shall sell any  
4 such beverages on Sundays between one o’clock antemeridian  
5 and twelve o’clock noon, in any county other than Suffolk no  
6 licensee under section twelve shall sell any such beverages on  
7 Christmas day, or on the day following when said day occurs  
8 on Sunday, or on the last Monday in May, between one  
9 o’clock antemeridian and twelve o’clock noon,” and inserting  
10 in place thereof the words: — no other licensee under section  
11 twelve shall sell any alcoholic beverages on Sunday between  
12 two o’clock antemeridian and eleven o’clock antemeridian and  
13 no licensee under section twelve shall sell any alcoholic beverage  
14 on Christmas day or on the day following when said day  
15 occurs on Sunday, or on the last Monday in May between two  
16 o’clock antemeridian and eleven o’clock antemeridian.
