AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TENURE RIGHTS OF A CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEE OF THE COMMONWEALTH PROMOTED TO A NON-CIVIL SERVICE POSITION IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 adding thereto the following new section: —
- 3 *Section 48C.* Whenever a civil service employee of the com-
- 4 monwealth is promoted to a non-civil service position in the
- 5 commonwealth said employee shall retain his tenure rights
- 6 under this chapter in the civil service position from which he
- 7 was promoted.
