AN ACT PERMITTING HUNTING OF COOT, EIDER AND OLD SQUAW DUCKS ON SUNDAYS FROM A BOAT OUTSIDE HARBOR LIMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 57 of chapter 131 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 214 of the acts of 1968
3 is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the follow-
4 ing sentence: — Nothing in this section shall prohibit hunt-
5 ing of coot, eider or old squaw ducks on Sundays from a boat
6 outside harbor limits in compliance with federal regulations.

1 SECTION 2. Section 6 of chapter 136 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after clause (46) inserted by
3 chapter 392 of the acts of 1968 the following clause:

4 (47). the hunting of coot, eider or old squaw ducks on
5 Sundays from a boat outside harbor limits as provided in
6 section 57 of chapter 131.
