AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF THE MASSACHUSETTS COMMISSION FOR THE BLIND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 129 of chapter 6, inserted by section 2 of chapter
2 535 of the acts of 1966 is hereby amended by striking out the
3 second sentence of the second paragraph and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: — He shall receive such salary
5 not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars, as the governor
6 may determine, and shall devote his entire time to the duties
7 of his office.
