By Mr. Weinberg of Boston (by request), petition of the Massachusetts Society of Professional Engineers relative to the salary of professional engineers in the employ of the Commonwealth. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS IN THE EMPLOY OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The provisions of chapter 547 of the acts of 1969 are
2 hereby amended by inserting after section 2(b) thereof the
3 following new subsection: —
4 *Section 2(c).* In addition to the wages set forth herein, any
5 employee of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts who is regis-
6 tered as a professional engineer with the Board of Registration
7 of Professional Engineers as set forth in Section 45 of Chapter
8 13 of the General Laws, and in accordance with the provisions
9 of Sections 81(d) through 81(t) of Chapter 112 of the General
10 Laws shall be paid Five hundred (\$500.00) dollars additional
11 increment as such registered or professional engineer.
