RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF REDUCING THE AGE REQUIREMENT OF CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AN EXEMPTION FROM REAL ESTATE TAXES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represen-
3 tatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study relative to the feasibility of reducing the age require-
6 ment from seventy to sixty-five years of age of certain elderly
7 persons to be eligible for an exemption from real estate taxes.
