AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF THE DRAWBRIDGE OVER BROAD CANAL AT THIRD STREET IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE, WHICH IS NOW CLOSED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

As amended to the 17th Amendment

AMENDMENT I
Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

AMENDMENT II
A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.

AMENDMENT III
No Soldier shall, in time of peace, be quartered in any house, without the consent of the owner, and in time of war, but in a manner to be prescribed by Law.
