**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

AN ACT PROHIBITING MOTOR VEHICLE RACING WITHIN CERTAIN  
CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 271 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 34 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 34A.* No land within a city or town having a
- 4 density of population of more than persons per
- 5 square mile shall be laid out or used as a race ground or race
- 6 track for racing of motor vehicles. Every such race ground or
- 7 race track established, laid out, used or continued in use
- 8 contrary to this section is declared a common nuisance and
- 9 may be abated as such; and all persons owning, keeping,
- 10 using or permitting to be used such race ground or race track,
- 11 or aiding or abetting therein, shall be punished by a fine of
- 12 not more than one thousand dollars or by imprisonment for
- 13 not more than one year, or both.
