AN ACT REQUIRING THE BOARD OF REGIONAL COMMUNITY COLLEGES, IN COOPERATION WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE NORFOLK COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL, TO ESTABLISH COURSES OF STUDY BEYOND THE SECONDARY LEVEL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 74 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 36 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 36A.* The board of regional community colleges, in
- 4 cooperation with the trustees of the Norfolk County Agricul-
- 5 tural School shall establish and maintain courses of instruction
- 6 at said school beyond the secondary level designed to prepare
- 7 students for greater opportunities for employment.
