AN ACT RELATIVE TO POLICE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION TO THE MEMBERS OF THE UNIFORMED BRANCH OF THE DIVISION OF PUBLIC SAFETY ASSIGNED TO ANY DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT, MEMBERS OF THE POLICE FORCE OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION, ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS APPOINTED BY THE REGISTRAR OF MOTOR VEHICLES, MEMBERS OF THE CAPITOL POLICE, MEMBERS OF THE METROPOLITAN BAY TRANSPORT AUTHORITY, MEMBERS OF EVERY FULL TIME POLICE DEPARTMENT OF EVERY CITY AND TOWN WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any other provision of chapter 31A new
2 section numbered section 10A shall be inserted to read, The
3 Director of Civil Service shall be directed that in all future
4 Entrance Examinations for the position of a full time Police
5 Officer, that the subject matter contained therein at least
6 Seventy Five Percent of questions taken from the book known
7 as a Manual for the Instruction of Application for Ex-
8 aminations for the Police Service.
