AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXPENSES OF THE ADVISORY BOARD OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 161A of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by deleting the fifth paragraph thereof
3 and inserting the following new paragraph: —

4 The advisory board may incur expenses, not to exceed forty
5 thousand dollars annually, for research, administration, and
6 stenographic and clerical work, and such expenses, incurred
7 after July third, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, shall be paid
8 by the authority.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
