AN ACT PROHIBITING THE TAKING OF LAND OF THE SAVIN HILL YACHT CLUB FOR THE CAMPUS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS AT COLUMBIA POINT IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the Trustees
2 of the University of Massachusetts shall not acquire by the
3 exercise of the power of eminent domain any land owned by
4 the Savin Hill Yacht Club for the establishment of a campus of
5 the University of Massachusetts at Columbia Point in the City
6 of Boston.

The following report of the Commissioners of the Land Office is submitted in response to a resolution of the Senate, passed May 11, 1903, relative to the land owned by the State.

The report is divided into two parts, the first of which contains a general statement of the land owned by the State, and the second a detailed statement of the land owned by the State in each county.

The first part of the report contains a general statement of the land owned by the State, and is divided into three sections, the first of which contains a statement of the land owned by the State in each county, the second a statement of the land owned by the State in each township, and the third a statement of the land owned by the State in each section.
