AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT TO CITIES AND TOWNS FOR SALARIES OF TEACHERS ENGAGED IN BI-LINGUAL EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The Commonwealth of Massachusetts shall for the period of
- 2 July 1, 1970, through June 30, 1976, reimburse to every city
- 3 and town in the Commonwealth sixty percent (60%) of the
- 4 salary of any teacher and/or instructor engaged in the instruc-
- 5 tion of non-English speaking children.
