AN ACT TO REGULATE POLITICAL COMMITTEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 52 is hereby amended by striking out section 10
- 2 and inserting in place thereof the following new section: —
- 3 *Section 10.* A state committee shall make rules and regula-
- 4 tions consistent with law for its proceedings and for the pro-
- 5 ceedings of the city and town committees of its political party.
- 6 Any violation by a city or town committee of the rules and
- 7 regulations adopted by the state committee shall cause the
- 8 dissolution of such city or town committee. The state commit-
- 9 tee shall provide for the reorganization of any dissolved city or
- 10 town committee.
