AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DUTIES OF THE DIRECTOR OF CIVIL SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2A of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapters 5 and 12 of the acts of 1969, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out clause (n) and inserting
4 in place thereof the following clause: —

5 (n) Develop programs and advise and assist appointing
6 authorities in promoting opportunities for employment of the
7 handicapped and ex-offenders against the laws of the Common-
8 wealth. The director shall take necessary steps to prevent
9 discrimination in the examination and appointment of such
10 persons to positions within the classified civil service. Upon
11 request by an aggrieved person, the commission shall review
12 action taken by the director or an appointing authority on the
13 basis of a handicap or conviction, or facts underlying either of
14 the same, to ascertain the effect of such conditions or facts on
15 the fitness of the applicant actually to perform the duties of
16 the position for which he is applying.
