AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO PAY THE SALARIES OF LAY TEACHERS IN PRIVATE SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding after clause (61) the following clause: —
3 (62) For the payment of the salaries of lay teachers in
4 private schools, including physical education teachers, provided,
5 however, that the curriculum therein has been approved by the
6 school committee of the city or town in which said school is
7 located, and provided, further that no such teacher shall teach
8 any religious doctrine or subject.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FIFTY OF THE GENERAL LAWS RELATIVE TO

THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, AS FOLLOWS:
