## **The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-One.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION ON THE PROBLEMS OF INCREASING POPULATION AND THE INITIATION OF COURSES AT ALL LEVELS OF EDUCATION ON SUCH SUBJECT MATTER.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two  
2 members of the Senate, four members of the House of Repre-  
3 sentatives, and three persons appointed by the Governor, one  
4 of whom shall be a physician licensed to practice in Mas-  
5 sachusetts, and one of whom shall be an economist, and one of  
6 whom shall be an educator, is hereby established for the  
7 purpose of studying the problems of increasing population as it  
8 will affect future generations in Massachusetts and to make  
9 recommendations with respect to encouraging the initiation of  
10 courses at all levels of education in Massachusetts on this  
11 subject. The commission shall report the results of its study  
12 and its recommendations, if any, to the General Court, to-  
13 gether with drafts of such legislation as may be necessary to  
14 carry such recommendations into effect, by filing same with  
15 the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the first  
16 Wednesday in December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
