Joseph Tully (by vote of the town of Pepperell) that town meetings of the town of Pepperell be authorized to be held in the North Middlesex Regional School Building located on the line dividing the town of Pepperell and Townsend. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE HOLDING OF TOWN MEETINGS OF THE TOWN OF PEPPERELL IN THE NORTH MIDDLESEX REGIONAL SCHOOL BUILDING LOCATED ON THE LINE DIVIDING THE TOWNS OF PEPPERELL AND TOWNSEND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the
2 contrary, the town of Pepperell, with the approval of the North
3 Middlesex Regional School District Committee, is hereby author-
4 ized to hold its regular and special town meetings in the North
5 Middlesex Regional school building which is on the town line
6 dividing the towns of Pepperell and Townsend.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
